The Nancy Buck Ransom Foundation (NBRF) was established to support the mission and operations of Crivitz Youth, Inc. (CYI), ensuring that Nancy Buck Ransom's vision of serving the Crivitz community continues for generations to come.

Nancy Buck Ransom was born in Chicago in 1925 and raised in New York. She spent many summers in Crivitz, developing a deep appreciation for the Northwoods and the people who called it home. After graduating from the University of Wisconsin, Nancy dedicated her career to education and continued to return to the Crivitz area throughout her life. Nancy was a mentor, advocate, and benefactor to many. In 1970, she and her mother, Constance Buck, founded Crivitz Youth, Inc. in memory of Nancy's father, Ellsworth Buck. Recognizing the need for positive opportunities for local youth, Nancy worked with community members to open a Teen Center in 1972. Over the years, CYI continued to grow to meet the changing needs of the community, expanding services with the addition of a preschool program in 1981, a Child Development Center in 1997, and the CYI Community Center in 2013.

Today, Crivitz Youth, Inc. continues Nancy's legacy by providing affordable programs, services, and opportunities that promote healthy lifestyles, personal growth, and community connection for individuals and families of all ages.

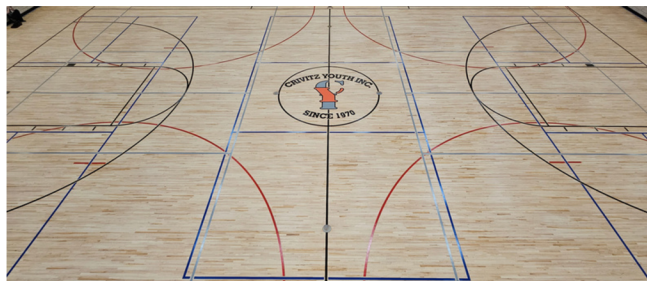

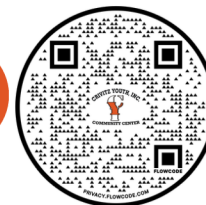
